What to bring:

- Bike and Helmet, if you'd like to bike the trail in Townsend. Helmets **MUST** be worn at all times while biking!!
- Tent, sleeping bag, pillow, flashlight or lantern
- Toiletries and extra clothing
- Rain Gear-Camporee runs rain or shine!!
- Sack lunch for Saturday. Don't forget snacks, a cooler and ice for your drinks.
- Folding chair or blanket to sit on.

Registration and Check In Procedures For Webelos Camporee



Check in at the Webelos Camping Area in the field beside the Great Smoky Mountain

Heritage Center, located 0.7 mile beyond the traffic light at the Hwy 321 and Hwy 73 intersection in Townsend. The Heritage Center is on the right side of the road, directly across the street from River Rat.

Planned Activities For Webelos Camporee

- Walking or Biking the trail in Townsend. You can bike as little or as much of this 10-mile historical trail as you wish. Brochures of the historical sites and trail will be provided at Camporee. All bikers **MUST** wear a helmet.
- Shooting Sports.
- Scavenger Hunt/Orienteering Course.
- Spaghetti Supper will be provided Saturday evening for registered campers.
- Webelos will have the opportunity to visit with Boy Scout Troops in their campsites Saturday evening and Sunday morning at breakfast, as well as at the Saturday evening Campfire Program. Each Pack must make **advanced reservations** with a Troop in order to dine with them at Camporee.
- Campfire Program after dinner Saturday evening.
- Chapel on Sunday morning.
